## LATE WAIVER FOR HORSE MEMBERS

According to the rules as set forth by the Union County 4-H Horse Committee during their regular meeting in (May of 1979), if a member fails to turn in the proper horse project identification card and picture(s) by the May 1 deadline, the member may be granted a "One Time Only" waiver, and that henceforth May 1<sup>st</sup> will be the deadline.
