

## 2020 Richwood Fair Livestock Requirement Summary\*\*

### Market Beef (Steers & Market Heifers)

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	Can register up to 4 steers and 4 heifers. Can show 2 steers and 2 heifers.
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	Animals must be owned and in possession of exhibitor by December 31, 2019.
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	MUST be tagged on Jan. 7, 2020.
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Beef Skillathon: (Pavillion), Thursday, September 3 at 10:15 am
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	Weigh-in: Wednesday, September 2 at 8:30 a.m.
<b>Show Time</b>	Show: Saturday, September 5 at 9 a.m.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 pm on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	All steers must be dehorned and castrated bulls. 900 lbs. weight min. for Steers and Market Heifers. Any animal not meeting the weight requirement will NOT be permitted to sell in the Jr. Fair Livestock sale.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	No health papers required. DUNF forms due at fair weigh-in.

### Beef Breeding (Heifers)

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	No limit on number of entries per class in Beef Breeding Classes.
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	June 1
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	None
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Beef Skillathon: (Pavillion), Thursday, September 3 at 10:15 am
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	No Weigh-in. No weight requirement, not eligible for Junior Fair Livestock Sale.
<b>Show Time</b>	Show: Saturday, September 5 at 9 a.m.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 pm on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	Enter in appropriate class based on age of animal.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	No health papers required.

### Beef Feeder Calves

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	May tag and show a maximum of 2 beef feeders.
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	July 15
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	Must self-tag by July 15. Tag in form available at RichwoodFair.com.
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Beef Skillathon: (Pavillion), Thursday, September 3 at 10:15 am
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	Weigh-in: Wednesday, September 2 at 8:30 a.m. This animal is eligible for the Jr. Fair Livestock Auction. The exhibitor has the option when going through the sale to refuse the buyback bid and take their project home. (The exhibitor will receive the premium sale amount)
<b>Show Time</b>	Show: Saturday, September 5 at 9 am
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 pm August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	Must weigh under 899 pounds. Animals must be a beef breed or beef cross, dehorned and castrated male by July 15
<b>Health Requirements</b>	No health papers required. DUNF forms due at fair weigh-in.

### Dairy Feeders

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	May show maximum of 2 animals (can tag-in maximum of 4)
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	June 1
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	Must be tagged and vaccinated on Saturday, June 6 from 11 am to 1 pm at the Richwood Fairgrounds. There is a \$ 10 fee per head for animals to be vaccinated.
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Beef Skillathon: (Pavillion), Thursday, September 3 at 10:15 a.m.
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	Weigh-in: Wednesday, September 2 at 8:30 a.m.
<b>Show Time</b>	Show: Saturday, September 5 at 9 a.m.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 pm on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	Must weigh between 400 and 700 lbs. Must be a 100% dairy breed, dehorned and castrated male by June 1 <sup>st</sup> . Any animal not within this weight range will NOT be permitted to sell in the Jr. Fair Livestock Sale.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	No health papers required. DUNF forms due at fair weigh-in. Must have been vaccinated at tag-in on June 6.

### Market Hogs

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	May show maximum of 3 single hogs. Maximum of 2 per sex to be shown. Maximum 6 tagged.
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	June 1
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	Photo ID forms required!!! Online self-tag in forms due by June 6. A Maximum of 6 head may be registered.
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Swine Skillathon Thursday, September 3, All ages at 11:30 a.m.
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	Weigh-in: Wednesday, September 2 at 9 a.m.
<b>Show Time</b>	Show: Thursday, September 3, 5 p.m. Show begins with showmanship and ends with market classes.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 p.m. on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	Must weigh between 210 and 285 lbs. Any animal not within this weight range will NOT be permitted to sell in the Jr. Fair Livestock Sale. Must have minimum of ½ inch hair length. No clipping of hogs at fair.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	No health papers required. DUNF due at fair weigh-in.

### Market Lambs

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	May tag-in maximum of 6. May show maximum of 4 individual lambs, 2 ewes and 2 wethers.
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	June 1
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	Must be tagged on Saturday, June 6 from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Richwood Fairgrounds.
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Sheep Skillathon, Wednesday, September 2 at 2:15 p.m.
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	Weigh-in: Wednesday, September 2 at 11 a.m.
<b>Show Time</b>	Sheep Show: Friday, September 4 at 12:30 p.m.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 p.m. on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	Must weigh between 95 and 140 lbs. to show and sell. Any animal not within this weight range will NOT be permitted to sell in the Jr. Fair Livestock Sale. All lambs must be shown slick shorn. All wethers must be properly castrated by June 1.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	All animals (ewes and rams) must have USDA approved scrapie tag. DUNF due at fair weigh in.

### Breeding Sheep

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	Only 1 entry per class.
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	June 1
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	None
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Sheep Skillathon, Wednesday, September 2 at 2:15 p.m.
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	No Weigh-in
<b>Show Time</b>	Sheep Show: Friday, September 4, at 12:30 p.m.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 p.m. on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	May show ewes or rams in appropriate age classes.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	All animals (ewes and rams) must have USDA approved scrapie tag.

### Market Goats

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	May tag in maximum of 4. May show maximum of 2.
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	June 1
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	Must be tagged on Saturday, June 6, from 8 am to 1 pm at the Richwood Fairgrounds. <b>Market Goats must be dehorned prior to tag-in.</b>
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Goat Skillathon – Thursday, September 3, 12:45 p.m.
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	Weigh-in: Wednesday, September 2, at 11 a.m.
<b>Show Time</b>	Goat Show: Wednesday, September 2, at 4:00 p.m. Show will begin with Showmanship Classes, then Breeding Classes, followed by Market Classes.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 pm on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	Must weigh between 55 and 110 lbs. Any animal not within this weight range will NOT be permitted to sell in the Jr. Fair Livestock Sale. Market Goats may be does or wethers. Must be dehorned and castrated by June 8.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	All market animals must have USDA approved scrapie tag. DUNF due at weigh-in.

### Breeding Goats

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	May show maximum of 1 entry per breed class.
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	June 1
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	None
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Goat Skillathon – Thursday, September 3, 12:45 p.m.
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	No Weigh-in
<b>Show Time</b>	Goat Show: Wednesday, September 2, at 4:00 p.m. Show will begin with Showmanship Classes, then Breeding Classes, followed by Market Classes.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 p.m. on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	Breeding goats are permitted to have horns.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	All animals must have USDA approved scrapie tag OR tattoos and registration papers. DUNF required for lactating dairy goats.

### Market Rabbits

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	Can tattoo 6 animals, can show 1 Pen of 3. Family tags are permitted; must be in same household.
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	Must own animals by August 8.
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	Mandatory tattooing on Saturday, August 8, 9 – 11 a.m. at the fairgrounds Rabbit Barn area.
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Rabbit Skillathon – Friday, September 4, 9:00 am
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	Weigh-in: Tuesday, September 1, at 6:45 p.m.
<b>Show Time</b>	Rabbit Show: Thursday, September 3, at 9 a.m. beginning with showmanship classes.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 p.m. on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	<p>Each rabbit in a pen must weigh between 3 ½ and 5 ½ lbs. to be shown and Jr. Fair Livestock Sale eligible. Any pen with an individual rabbit which is not within this weight range is ineligible to sell in the Jr. Fair Livestock Sale. Rabbit pens sold in Jr. Fair Sale are terminal (all go to the resale bidder). 4-H members must be enrolled in Project #226, Market Rabbits.</p> <p>Official Scales will open one hour before weigh in for exhibitors to check the weights of the animals they are exhibiting at the fair. These weights will be unofficial and will in no way be considered valid once official weigh in has begun. Scales will be available at first come, first serve basis and exhibitors should respect the other exhibitors' right to use the scales as well.</p>
<b>Health Requirements</b>	DUNF required at weigh-in (One form per whole pen). Will be veterinarian inspected at the fair.

### Breeding Rabbits

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	Maximum entries per exhibitor: Jr. age exhibitor = 2 entries; Intermediate age exhibitor = 3 entries; 14 – 18 year olds – 4 entries. (Age as of 1/1/18).
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	June 1
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	None
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Not Required
<b>Skillathon</b>	Rabbit Skillathon – Friday, September 4, 9:00 a.m.
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	None
<b>Show Time</b>	Rabbit Show: Thursday, September 3, at 9 a.m. beginning with showmanship classes. Breeding rabbits are not weighed as they are not eligible for the Junior Fair Livestock Sale.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 p.m. on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	This is not an ARBA Show but animals must show predominate breed characteristics. 4-H members must be enrolled in Project #225, Breeding Rabbit. All rabbits must have permanent ID.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	No health papers required. Will be veterinarian inspected at the fair. Enter fairgrounds from 4 – 6:30 pm (not before) on Tuesday, September 1.

### Broilers (Meat Chickens – Pen of 4)

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	Must bring 1 pen of 4 Broilers, and will show 3 of the 4.
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	Must have been hatched on or after July 15, 2020 and owned within 48 hours of hatch date.
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	None
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Poultry Skillathon – Thursday, September 3, 9:00 a.m.
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	Pen of 4 Weigh-in: Tuesday, September 1, at 6:45 p.m.
<b>Showmanship Time</b>	Poultry Show and Showmanship: Wednesday, September 2, at 9 a.m.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 p.m. on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	<p>Each bird must weigh a minimum of 4 lbs. and a maximum of 7 lbs. Any pen with an individual bird which is not within this weight range is ineligible to sell in the Jr. Fair Livestock Sale.</p> <p>Official Scales will open one hour before weigh in for exhibitors to check the weights of the animals they are exhibiting at the fair. These weights will be unofficial and will in no way be considered valid once official weigh in has begun. Scales will be available at first come, first serve basis and exhibitors should respect the other exhibitors' right to use the scales as well.</p>
<b>Health Requirements</b>	Must present NPIP hatchery papers at weigh-in.

### Fancy Poultry, Pullets, Ducks & Geese, Exhibition Turkey

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	Only 1 entry per class. Some exhibits consist of 2 or 3 birds. See fair book for class details.
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	June 1 for Fancy Poultry, Pullets & Geese. For Market Duck: must be owned 48 hours after hatching; hatched on or after June 17, 2020.
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	None
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Not Required except for Market Duck. Youth exhibitors of Market Ducks must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Poultry Skillathon – Thursday, September 3, 9:00 a.m.
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	None
<b>Showmanship Time</b>	Poultry Show and Showmanship: Wednesday, September 2, at 9 a.m.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 p.m. on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	Not eligible for Junior Fair Livestock Sale.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	NPIP papers required immediately following barn meeting.

## Market Turkeys

<b>Exhibit Limit</b>	Turkeys: Can show 1 commercial Tom Turkey
<b>Ownership Deadline</b>	Turkeys: 48 hours after hatching. Must have been hatched on or after May 20, 2020
<b>Tag-in Required</b>	None
<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Youth exhibitors must participate in Quality Assurance Education (QA) by July 1 to be eligible to show. See Quality Assurance Flyer for approved QA options.
<b>Skillathon</b>	Poultry Skillathon – Thursday, September 3, 9:00 a.m.
<b>Fair Weigh-in</b>	Turkeys will not be weighed.
<b>Showmanship Time</b>	Poultry Show and Showmanship, Wednesday, September 2, at 9 am. Market Turkeys will be sold in Jr. Fair Livestock Sale. Exhibitors must submit sale designation form immediately following Poultry show to be eligible to sell.
<b>Entries</b>	Orange fair entry cards with advisor signature must be in by 4 p.m. on August 1.
<b>Weight &amp; Other Requirements</b>	Turkeys may be debeaked, de-toed, or any practice accepted in the commercial production of meat turkeys.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	Must present NPIP hatchery papers immediately following barn meeting.
