Other Rule Changes:

Department 5: Beef Feeders and Dairy Beef Feeders

Dairy Feeder Calves must be brought to tag-in and testing on June 7 to be eligible to show. To be eligible to show as a Dairy Feeder, calves must be a minimum of 51% dairy breeds. Calves tested as 51% or greater of a beef breed(s) must show as beef feeders.

Department 7: Swine

Weight range: Market Hog 210 – 300 pounds

No use of snares or snare-like restraints on the fairgrounds.
