Hello Rabbit Exhibitors:

## You are receiving this note because you have entered a rabbit(s) to exhibit at the Union County Fair

It is highly recommended (not required) that you bring a Cage Riser for your rabbit cage.

Here are some details:

- A riser serves to keep the rabbit out of the shavings on the cage floor, and therefore cleaner.
- Cage risers are commercially available, but probably only online (not somewhere local).
- It is fine to make your own riser, even if it's a temporary one for the fair. You will need one for each cage/exhibit you are bringing. Do not use wood when building a riser (wood will retain moisture, odor and bacteria).
- The cages are 21 inches by 21 inches; therefore your riser should be 20 inches by 20 inches.

Note: it is important that it folds in the middle in order to fit into the cage door (see sample pics below).
