Union County 4-H Teen Opportunities

Cloverbud Teen Leader

Teens are needed to serve as leaders for monthly Cloverbud meetings. In this role you will assist with opening sessions, help conduct meeting activities, serve snack, lead songs, assist Cloverbud members with things like moving from session to session, and joining in all meeting activities. Junior Fair Board: Union County

As a member of the Junior Fair Board your role will be to help set up, organize, and implement the Jr Fair events, shows, and activities. You will be responsible for tasks such as setting up pens/cages/stalls, judging areas, chairs, etc, organizing exhibitors for classes, interviews, photos, etc., utilizing PA system to conduct judging and shows, recording results, collecting forms, answering questions from exhibitors and families, working with judges, show officials, and Committee members, preparing ribbons, awards, and paperwork for events. You will need to be available during Fair week and for 3-4 meetings prior to the Fair from February through July. The deadline to submit the application for the Union County Junior Fair Board is February 1.

Junior Fair Board: Richwood

As a member of the Junior Fair Board your role will be to help set up, organize, and implement the Jr Fair events, shows, and activities. You will be responsible for tasks such as setting up pens/cages/stalls, judging areas, chairs, etc., organizing exhibitors for classes, interviews, photos, etc., utilizing PA system to conduct judging and shows, recording results, collecting forms, answering questions from exhibitors and families, working with judges, show officials, and Committee members, preparing ribbons, awards, and paperwork for events. You will need to be available during Fair week and for 3-5 meetings and work days prior to the Fair from March through August. The deadline for the Richwood Junior Fair Board is March 1.
